Roads – South Cookney Road very badly potholed, but has had some temporary repair. Residents have complained that grit bins at Cookney Church were empty. Suggest notify Roads dept about keeping all bins filled. Cllr Melling will ask about litter picks (available free from Council).

Western Peripheral Route – Cllr Mollison senses a delay possible.

New Hose at West Cookney – Agreed to contact Planning Dept to point out that West Cookney NOT in Rural Housing Market Area (RHMA) Neighbours had not objected.

Local Development Plan (LDP) – Main Issues Report (MIR) – Rob reported that he attended the Area Committee discussion of policies (January 26th). Policy amendments due to go to ISC soon and full Council by May. Further chance to object when finalised plan published. Two day discussion of housing development bids at Area Committee on March 9th and 10th. Councillors to ask for approximate timings for discussion of each area.

Banchory-Leggart – Presentation at RGU but C.C. were not invited.

Bancon – Nothing new.

Elsick – Nothing new.

Meikle Carewe – Nothing to report .

Changes in Planning System – Newtonhill and Cammachmore CC would like to see the plans and other information on Shire website before 21 day consultation period commences. The next Forum would be on 25 February and N&CCC would like all 12 CCs to present a united front – letter read out by Rob. Cllr Melling has asked for clarification from Raymond Reid, he agreed we should write as he felt the democratic process is being undermined. Agreed to write to Christine Gore, with a copy to Raymond Reid; to Area Manager to add subject to agenda of next Community Council Forum; to Transport Minister for clarification and to Association of Scottish Community Councils.

Planning Applications on our website. He suggests writing to Transport Minister for clarification and inform other CCs to do the same. RW to contact Maureen Corley before writing and to inform all twelve Kincardine and Mearns CCs of our action.
